Aisle-walkway

Custodian/Janitor-cleaning people

Plug-(auf Deutsch Stecker)

Electrical Outlet/Socket- (auf Deutsch Steckdose)

Appliance-an electrical device: for example: computer, tv, ipod

Apparatus-the equipment you are using in your laboratory experiment

Waft/Hand Wave Technique – method used for smelling a chemical

Dilute – to make less concentrated

ACID INTO WATER

Myopia-eye disorder (nearsightedness)

Ignite – to catch on fire

Volatile – how easily a substance vaporizes

Lubricate – to make slippery

Vinegar (essig) – weak acid

Baking Soda (NaHCO_3) – sodium bicarbonate OR sodium hydrogen carbonate – a weak base

Neutralization: acid + base \rightarrow salt + water
