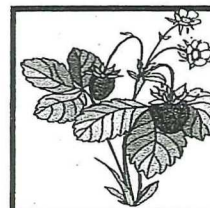

Cow

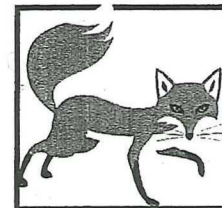
Heterotroph

Organisms that make their own food



Use sunlight to photosynthesize.

Cactus



Organisms that absorb and break down dead matter into chemical parts so nutrition can be recycled into the soil

Heterotroph

Organisms that get their food through other sources

Detritivores consume dead plant and animal matter and feces so decomposers can break it down further

Autotroph



Group consists of herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores - scavengers too
